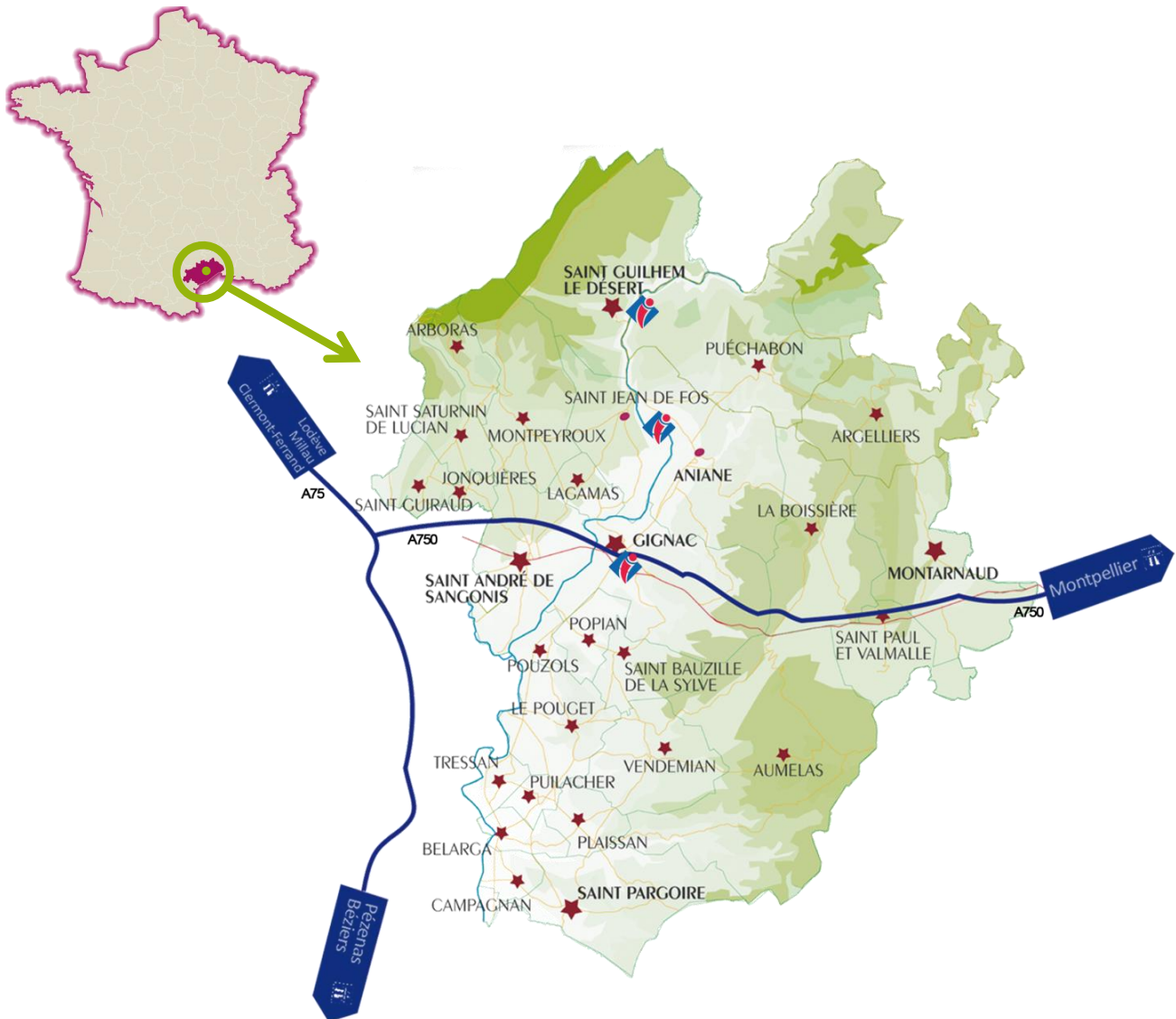

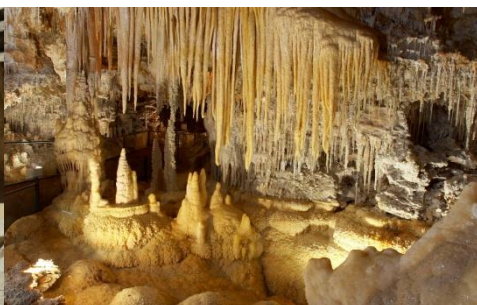

The vineyards of the Herault valley

The "Vallée de l'Hérault" has an exceptional climate and soil. The river Herault digs through the rock, goes through the garrigue before emerging through the vineyard of the Vallée de l'Hérault. To this is added a rich and complex geological history in favor to the elaboration of great wines.

To enhance this work, the great majority of the wines of the territory are produced in *Indication Géographique* (IG - Geographical Indication) divided into *Indications Géographiques Protégées* (IGP - Protected Geographical Indications) and *Appellations d'Origine Contrôlée* (AOC).

Each year, in addition to the *Pays d'Oc* wines and *Pays d'Hérault* wines, a wine contest is organized in the Vallée de l'Hérault and rewards the best wines: *IGP Saint-Guilhem-le-Désert*, and *Vicomté d'Aumelas* and honors the *AOC Terrasses du Larzac* and the *AOC Languedoc*.

What's more, the specific "terroirs" of *Grés de Montpellier*, *Montpeyroux* and *Saint-Saturnin-de-Lucian* are denominations inside the *AOC Languedoc*.



"Languedoc Cœur d'Hérault", a certified destination

The Vallée de l'Hérault is part of the "Languedoc, Cœur d'Hérault" destination, certified "Vignobles et Découvertes" (Vineyards and Discoveries). The vineyard, omnipresent, shapes the landscapes dotted with vines and olive trees, "capitelles" (dry stone huts), mazets, dry stone walls ...

As for the winegrowers, they bear high the colors of a Languedoc tradition : generosity and conviviality.

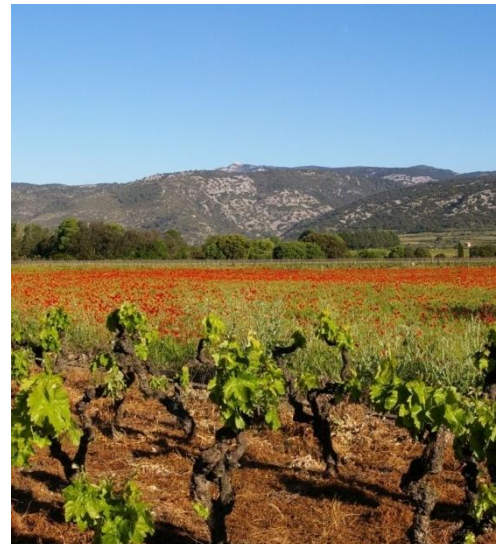
